Volunteering:

Next week I will send home a *Volunteer Availability Form*. Please fill it out and return it to school as soon as possible. **Volunteering will start in October**, which gives the children and myself adequate time to become familiar with each other and with the routines of the class. A volunteer schedule will be made and posted on my e-teacher page. (I will send an email notifying you when this schedule is available.) All classroom volunteers need a current police check, so please start this process as soon as possible - contact the office for more information. If you are unable to make the day you are scheduled for I kindly ask that you **find a**

replacement, as we often have activities planned that we are unable to do without your presence. Your time in the classroom is so appreciated! ☺ Thank-you!

Eating at school:

At school, your child will be given the opportunity to **eat two times** a day - a snack in the morning at 10:15am and lunch at 12:30pm. Your child is given 15 minutes to eat their snacks and 25 minutes to eat their lunch. They will learn to eat more quickly as the days pass so please do not be too concerned if they don't eat their entire lunch. *Please be advised that Calgary Christian School is a **nut-free school**.*
* We do have a **microwave**, and if you'd like to send food that needs to be heated up I can help the children with this!

Absences/Lates:

If you know you will be away in advance, please send me an email or write me a note and call the office to let them know. If your child is sick or they will not be coming into school that day- please call the office so we do not worry. There is a link on the CCS website where you can enter when your child is late or absent. If you are late, please go to the office right away to get a late slip and then you may send your child to class.

Birthdays:

Birthdays are very exciting times for your child. If you would like to send in a birthday treat to share with the class- please feel free to do so as long as: there is enough for the whole class (17 students) and it is nut free.

*If you'd like to invite students in the class to your child's birthday party, please hand them to me directly. I will place them in the appropriate **Home Folders**. Please don't have your child hand them out, as some children may feel left out.

Sharing:

Sharing is a big part of Kindergarten; we encourage sharing so that your child is comfortable speaking in front of his/her peers and so that he/she has time to practice answering questions. During the month of September, your child is allowed to bring something in to share with the class that is interesting or important to them. Our sharing will take place on Mondays and Wednesdays. This is an excellent opportunity for the class to learn about each other! *Boys* are welcome to bring in something to share on *Mondays*. *Girls* can bring something to share on *Wednesdays*.

Homework:

Your child will bring home the September Homework Package on Monday, September 9th. The intent behind the homework activities is to improve your child's fine & gross motor capacity as well as reinforce the concepts being learned at school. We have tried to create activities that are fun and engaging for both you and your child; however, we never want the homework activities to become punitive. Please try to complete as many of the activities as possible, have your child colour in the squares as the activities are completed, and return the Homework Package to school on Monday, September 30th.

Classroom Helper

Your child will take turns being the "Citizen of the Day" in class! His/her responsibilities include: being the line leader, helping others if they need help, passing things out etc. The students love the opportunity to show leadership in the classroom! ☺

Literacy:

Our Literacy program will begin with the letter P and we will be starting to write in our classroom journals! We will be sending home a flash card each week. Please keep these flashcards, collect them on the ring, and store them in a safe place at home in order to *review* the letters as we learn them in class (which includes sounds, letter formation and sight recognition of the letters covered).

Library:

Students will travel to the library where our librarian Mrs. Thiessen will read them a story and allow them to take out a picture book. Your child may borrow this book for the week until their next Library time. Your child's Library slot is on Wednesday afternoons.

Scholastic Book Orders

Scholastic Canada offers books for sale at very reasonable prices. New book order forms will be sent home at the start of each new month. There will be a "return by" date stamped on the front to let you know when orders are due back to school, *if* you choose to purchase. *THIS PROGRAM IS TOTALLY OPTIONAL!*
